Course Content:

Painting with watercolours can be a lot of fun! This class is perfect for absolute beginners or those who wish to perfect their technique.

This class explores watercolour painting techniques, including mixing colours, laying washes, glazing and incorporating mixed media.

You will come away with a feeling of wonder and addiction to this extraordinary art form.

Materials:

- A4 Watercolour Sketch Pad (180-300gsm),
- 3 tubes of Watercolour Paint – ultramarine or cobalt blue,
- warm or cool yellow and a cadmium or crimson red and burnt sienna or brown, alternatively you could purchase watercolour paints in a cake,
- Watercolour brushes: a small round brush (1 or 2), a medium round brush (4 or 5) and a large flat brush (8),
- a palette,
- a cloth or rag
- a grey lead pencil and eraser

About the tutor:

Farimah graduated in Fine Arts from the Accademia di Belle Arti of Bologna, Italy. She has staged numerous exhibitions in Italy, Ecuador and Australia.

Farimah has participated in national and international art competitions, winning numerous prizes and recognitions. Farimah holds a Graduate Diploma of Teaching from the University of Melbourne and teaches art at Box Hill Institute, CAE, Swinburne and at many community centres.
