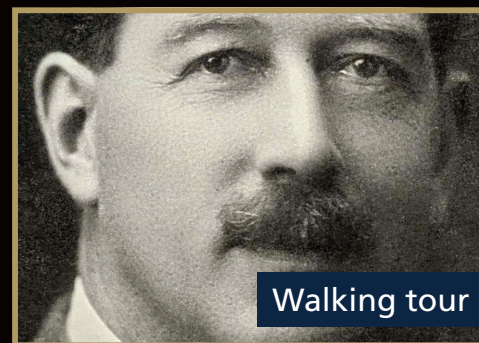
### A CAPPELLA HARMONY SINGING BY LOCAL CHORUSES

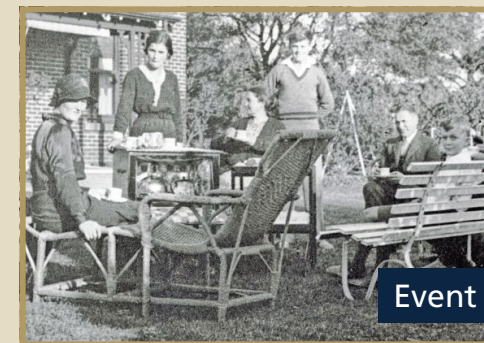
