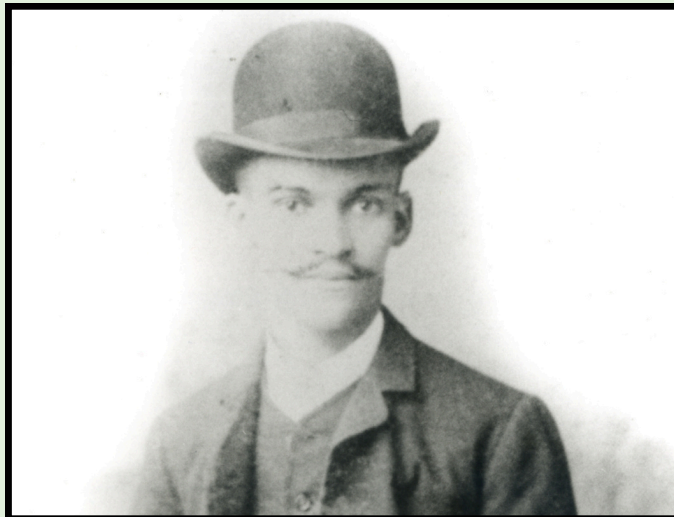




Strathdon House & Orchard Precinct, Our Streets

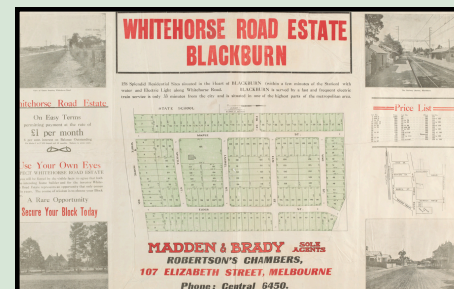
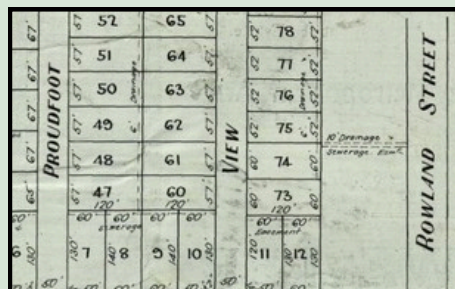
Shutter City: Fragments of a Forgotten Melbourne
